Thank you for participating in the 2017 Tenant-Landlord Food Drive. Please read the Ottawa Food Bank food drive guidelines below. This will help us work together to achieve the best possible result and help your donation go even further.

Boxes and Food Drive Materials

- Do not leave food boxes unattended in a lobby / public area. This food drive is designed to take place on Wednesday, April 19th.
- **Do not write on any Ottawa Food Bank food drive boxes.** Boxes are costly and we re-use them when possible.
- Please ensure your unused boxes are in safe and secure location. Food Drive boxes are the
 property of the Ottawa Food Bank. Please return any unused Ottawa Food Bank food drive boxes
 with your donations.
- Make your donation go further by using your own boxes. Bulk paper boxes/banker boxes work great!
 You do not need to use the Ottawa Food Bank boxes but, if you do not have access to your own, we will certainly provide them for you.
- Six of each poster will be provided. If you require more you can print them from our website.
- Please review documents provided to assist with your food drive.
