DID YOU KNOW? The Ottawa Food Bank grows fresh produce on our own 8-acre farm near Stittsville? This farmland was generously donated to us by Tom Black and his family over a decade ago. Our farm plays an important role in helping deliver fresh and nutritious produce to our 112 member agency food bank partners, who collectively support tens of thousands of people every single month. In 2020, we planted 18 crop varieties and harvested over 122,500 lbs of produce!

Adopt a Crop, presented by **Mondeau Bathroom & Kitchen**, invites local businesses to get involved. Choose a crop and champion it over the course of the 2021 growing season (May – October). In addition to supporting the Ottawa Food Bank, our Adopt a Crop Ambassador Groups will have access to a full season of exciting programming that can be shared with your team and enjoyed company-wide.

ADOPT A CROP AMBASSADOR BENEFITS - \$5,000

- Company selection of their 'Adopted Crop', based on a first committed, first served basis.
- Company (text) recognition as an Adopt a Crop Ambassador:
 - On the Ottawa Food Bank Community Harvest webpage and in 2021 program related communication.
 - On printed signage displayed at the farm during the 2021 season.
- (4) x 3 hour Adopt a Crop volunteer shifts** for up to 10 employees (per shift) at Ottawa Food Bank's Community Harvest Farm. Adopt a Crop volunteer shifts will include:
 - An Ottawa Food Bank representative onsite to engage with group for 2 of the 4 shifts.
 - Refreshments provided by our local food partners.
- A monthly Adopt a Crop newsletter featuring:
 - Seasonal recipe developed by Ottawa Food Bank's Registered Dietician, Jill Burns.
 - Farm updates from Jason Gray, Community Harvest Farmer.
 - General Ottawa Food Bank stories and updates.
- (2) Virtual cooking class led by local chefs, featuring seasonal recipes. With appearances by Ottawa Food Bank's CEO, Community Harvest Manager and Registered Dietician.
- 2021 Adopt a Crop certificate celebrating Ambassadors' involvement and support.
- A charitable tax receipt for the maximum allowable amount.

** Availability of volunteer shifts will be based on first committed, first served basis and will be weather dependent. When possible Ambassadors will be assigned tasks related to their crop. Additional details to be provided in program agreement.*
